

AIIVI All In Ministry

Life Together Classes:

AIM will provide training and awareness education for teachers, leaders and peers to include topics like creating an inclusive environment for all.

Buddy Mentor Program:

Trained adults and senior high teens who show compassion and are able to connect 1:1 in partnership to children with disabilities.

Children's Church Program: This sermon model designed for children ages 4-8 may be piloted to extend to youth through age 18 with special needs on a once-amonth basis. Customized worship experiences to children with disabilities, their family members, mentors and other volunteers would include interactive, multi-sensory, disability-sensitive worship event!
